5 MONTH OLD BABY SUGAR GLIDERS

About three months ago the Eco Station took in two baby sugar gliders from Thailand that were only 6 weeks old! Normally these marsupials would stay in their mom's pouch until they are at least 8 weeks old, but since they were unfortunately separated from their mom, it became the Eco staff's job to care for and nourish them and make them feel safe and at home. Now at almost 5 months old, these boys have grown into spunky, friendly, healthy and adorable gliders!

As cute as they are, sugar gliders are illegal to have as a pet in California as they are an invasive species that would eat ALL the bugs they could possibly find. These guys are nocturnal so they tend to spend most of the day sleeping, but when they do poke their heads out, it is quite a treat to our visitors. The best chance to get a glimpse of these cute babies is through our Eco Summer Camp Program where kids get an up close and personal experience with all of our exciting animals!

The Softest of Them All! **Rescued Chinchilla!**

Meet Minccino, one of two chinchillas currently living at the Eco Station. Minccino was recently rescued after someone had her as a pet, but their landlord did not allow pets so they brought her to the Eco Station for us to care for her. Many people get chinchillas as pets because they are so fluffy and adorable, and later realize that they don't always make the greatest pets because they typically aren't used to people, they are nocturnal, and can be very loud and messy.

While chinchillas are commonly seen as pets, they are not so commonly seen in the wild. Chinchillas in the wild are endangered because people will hunt them for their super soft fur. Chinchillas are believed to have the softest coat of all the land mammals, (it is very dense and has 50-80 hairs growing out of a single follicle, verses humans who have 1-3 hairs per follicle) this soft coat would keep them nice and warm in their natural home in the snowy Andes mountains!

Minccino's favorite things are running on her wheel, eating hay, and getting cuddles! You may be able to get a feel of her fluff on your next visit to the Eco Station.

Chinchillas are native to the Andes mountains in South America at high elevations of up to 4,270 meters.
